CATCON undertakes to conduct business and project activities in full compliance with statutory, certification and contractual requirements. CATCON will retain third party certification of its Management System to the requirements of AS4801 and the Australian Government Building and Construction WHS Accreditation Scheme.

CATCON is committed to developing the knowledge and competence of our people, providing appropriate resources to our national operations and supporting industry initiatives for safety improvements.
